

Call for Papers II INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF SEPHARDIC STUDIES (II CIES)

The second edition of CIES (Portuguese acronym for International Congress of Sephardic Studies), an initiative of CEJA (Center of Jewish Studies of the Amazon), will take place on August 16-20, 2023, in presential mode, in the city of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. The place of the event will soon be announced.

The Call for Papers is open from November 01th, 2022 to January 31th, 2023. Graduate and non-graduate students, professors and independent scholars of Sephardic Studies are invited to participate in the II CIES. Modest charges, soon to be listed and published, will help to defray some of the costs of putting together our Second congress.

The theme Sephardism can be presented by any topic in one of these contexts: historical, geographical, literary, theatrical, linguistic, social, religious, musical, scientific, gastronomic, transnational, spiritual or biographic.

1. Registration:

- **a**. Graduate and non-graduate students (the latter must have their subject approved by an instructor at their institution), professors, independent scholars in the study of Sephardism are welcome.

d. Results regarding the submitted paper (whether accepted or not) will be sent within 15 days of arrival at the II CIES e-mail (cies-ceja@gmail.com)

2. Presentation of the work:

- **a**. Unless applicants make a specific request, panels will be distributed according to the axes identified in the entry and paper submission.
- b. Each oral presentation may not exceed 20 minutes and may not be less than fifteen minutes.
- c. If the presentation of the work requires slides, please write a Note as the final item of the Abstract.

3. Daily schedule:

- **a.** The event shall consist of panels or individual presentations; after the presentation of all panels and individual works (if applicable), there will be a period of 15 minutes for questions from the public and answers from the participants.
- **b**. The daily event will consist of presentations in the morning, from 10:00am to 12:30pm, plus 15 minutes for questions; in the afternoon, it will be from 2:00pm to 5:30pm, plus 15 minutes for questions (Brasilia time).

4. Certificate

- **a**. Upon the participant's request, II CIES shall provide a Certificate of Participation at a date to be disclosed after the event. The information contained in the Certificate are: Name of the event; Author's name; Title of the work submitted; date of the presentation.
- **b**. The Certificate shall be sent as Document Enclosed to the e-mail inserted in the registration form.

5. Publication

- a. II CIES undertakes to publish the approved and presented papers at the Congress if the financial possibilities allow. Authors whose works will be in the publication plans will be sent a template of "Permission to publication" to be read and signed in a timely manner.
- b. Texts written in English, Spanish or Ladino whose authors approve their publication must follow the MLA style; texts written in Portuguese must follow the ABNT style.
- c. The deadline for sending the final text will be disclosed during the Congress.
